

# 2017 Honorary Canadian was awarded to Dr. Courtney W. Shropshire

Courtney Shropshire (July 10, 1877-1965), a prominent doctor in Birmingham, Alabama, was the founder and first President of Civitan International.

Shropshire remains the only individual to serve two terms as International President.

After his terms ended, Shropshire continued to actively promote Civitan. He was a frequent speaker at Civitan's International Conventions, and he visited clubs across the country until his death in 1965.




