Nomination: Submission for this award must be in writing and mailed to Civitan Club of Perth Inc., P.O. Box 20144, Perth, Ontario K7H 3M6 or emailed to perth.civitan.club.1965@hotmail.com

Submission: Completed submissions must be received no later than **Saturday, September 30th, 2017** Presentation ; To be presented at the annual STAMPEDE STEAKOUT (event hosted by Civitan Club of Perth) to a local resident who has went above & beyond to make their community a better place with no monetary gain for themselves.

Criteria: Being a Civitan Hometown Hero to someone in the community can be....

a personal act of kindness towards those less fortunate or in need

- providing a community service to the community at large (playing Santa or any similar act)
- volunteering at the local Food Bank, hospital or other charitable cause
- a community project that the nominee was either the chairperson or very involved (hands on) in the project
- making recommended changes for the betterment of the community and then implementing those changes
- volunteering their time to coach and/or mentor other members of the community
- acts that positively impact the quality of community members lives.

Selection Committee: This committee shall consist of 6 current, active Perth Civitan Club members. Decision of this committee is final.

Quorum: A quorum of the Selection Committee shall be considered 50% plus one committee members (Committee of 6 = 4 members must be present)

Hometown Heroes Award can be picked up at Twp of Drummond/North Elmsley office (310 Port Elmsley Road, RR 5, Perth); Tay Valley Twp office (217 Harper Road, Tay Valley) and Town of Perth office - back counter (80 Gore Street East, Perth)
